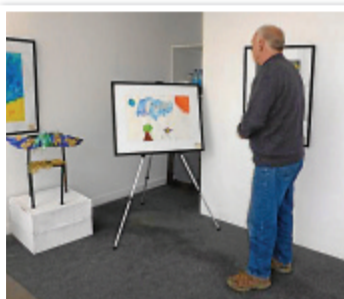
A wet weather venue will be available.
